Commission Regulation 07-07 Amendment #2 - Upland Game Seasons - Action

ECABMW will review make recommendations to the State Wildlife Commission on hunting seasons for upland game, rabbit, dove and crow seasons and trapping sealing dates for furbearing mammals.

Tag Application and Hunt Committee -Action

ECABMW will review and may make recommendations on the TAAHC.

Commission General Regulation 357 - LCB File No. R059-08 - Action

ECABMW will review and may make recommendations to the Commission on proposed amended regulation relating to classifying the gray wolf as a game mammal; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Commission General Regulation 358 - R066-08 - Action

ECABMW will review and may make recommendations to the Commission on proposed revision of the circumstances under which a resident of Nevada or nonresident is eligible to apply for a tag to hunt an antelope, bighorn sheep or mountain goat; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Commission General Regulation 359 - R068-08 - Action

ECABMW will review and may make recommendations to the Commission on proposed amended language requiring the Department of Wildlife to return the fees submitted for a tag for a subspecies of bighorn sheep or mountain goat under certain circumstances; prohibiting the Department from returning the fees submitted for a tag for elk or deer under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
