The Town Advisory Board of the Unincorporated Town of Montello, Met in a regular session on June 1, 2010 at 12:00 P.M. at the Montello community center at 4th and A Street in Montello, Nevada.

All Advisory Board members were present.

The proceedings were as follows: Mary Temoke called the meeting to order at 12:10 P.M.

Laura Bennett read the minutes from the last meeting. Mary Temoke approved the minutes and Laura Bennett 2nd the approval. All other members approved the minutes.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: Brice Kimber wanted to know who was doing all of the work on the park. Jill Neumann Stated that it was John McReynolds and that the park was looking great. Brice wanted to compliment John on the good work. Everyone agreed to that.

Brice also wanted to make sure that the Community building and the courthouse/jail would not ever be destroyed. We will put it on the next agenda to make a plaque stating that the buildings not be destroyed.

DISCUSSION ON THE CLEANUP AND AQUIRING PAPERWORK FOR THE MONTELLO CEMETARY AND ALL OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO. Jill Neumann stated that she would like to see the cemetery cleaned up. She also would like for the advisory board to have copies of the paperwork that has all of the information on the cemetery. She stated that if something happened to Fritz, we would not know who was to be in which vacant plot. Donna Wells stated that they used to do a community service for the school and the school could help in the cleanup. We agreed to that. We could also have a day for the community to come out and help.

DISCUSSION ON MATTERS RELATED TO CENTENIAL PARK AND ALL OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERTO: Mary Temoke stated that Kevin Bivins had his RV parked on the right of way in front of the park. He was not able to get to his property because his road was too muddy. She stated that Leena Carol had called the Sheriff's office and said that he was parked on her property and she would like him removed. This was confirmed by the sheriff's office in Wells. The sheriff's office came out and told him that he could not park on her property. Kevin told them that this is a community park and he was parked in the town right of way. He was still asked to leave. Mary Temoke stated that she talked to the sheriff's department about this incident and they now know that this is a community park and not the Carroll's property. The Carroll's own the property next to the park. Mary Temoke stated that she would like to do a petition against the Carroll's for public nuisance and harassment. Claudia Nance asked why the Carroll's were not able to be there to stand up for themselves Claudia stated that it was not fair, it was not on the agenda. Mary Temoke stated that it was an agenda item and the Carroll's were here yesterday. Mary Temoke made a motion to have a petition made up to bring around town. Clara Lee and Laura Bennett both seconded the motion Claudia Nance and Jill Neumann had to abstain from voting due to family issues relating to the park. Claudia Nance did not abstain from talking during this agenda item.

BOARD MEMBER AND COUNTY COMMENTS: The next board meeting will be on August 3rd. Items on the agenda. Action Item: Making the Centennial Park a rest stop for the Elko County Web site. Action Item: Plaque stating that the Court house, jail and Community building are not to be destroyed.
