The meeting was called to order by Laura Bennett at 6:05 P.M.

It was brought up at the last meeting by Laura Bennett that the Tecoma Valley Fire Department would like to have the telephone bill paid by the county instead of it coming out of the Fire department checking account. The Fire department needs to use the money for other items. The county is already paying for the electricity and water.
