EARLY VOTING

ABSENTEE VOTING

If you would like to request an absentee ballot, you must submit your request in writing to the Elko County Clerk's Office no later than Tuesday, October 28, 2008. Follow the instructions included with your ballot on how to complete your ballot and return it to our office in the envelope provided. Remember to complete and sign the return envelope. Your Absentee Ballot must be in the County Clerk's Office by 7:00 p.m. on election day, November 4, 2008 or it will not be counted.

The Sample Ballot indicates exactly what will be on your Official Ballot; mark it, and take it with you to your polling location to expedite the voting process. The mailing label on the Sample Ballot indicates the address of your polling location and the precinct in which you are registered.
