

**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)  
PUBLIC SAFETY E-911/NEXT GEN 911 COMMUNICATIONS CONSULTING SERVICES**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to an order of the Board of County Commissioners, County of Elko, State of Nevada, made at a regular meeting of the Board on the 5th day of April, 2017; said Board will receive separate, sealed proposals from qualified consulting firms to conduct a thorough needs analysis of the Elko County 911 telephone communications system. Professional services are sought to develop options and recommendations for Elko County to upgrade its legacy 911 communications.

The new system should provide full E-911 services to the entire county. Receipt of recommendations and plans, will be assessed by the Elko County E911 Advisory Board. The E911 Advisory Board may make a decision to award the work document for its professional services agreement to include procurement support and implementation support (phases 2 and 3). If all submissions are rejected the board will start the process over.

Minor, at 540 Court Street, Suite 101, Elko, Nevada 89801 no later than 4:30 p.m. (Pacific Time), on Friday, May 19, 2017. Proposals will be opened at 4:35 p.m. (Pacific Time) on the same day and the same location. Elko County reserves the right to reject any and all proposals or to accept such proposal as deemed best and to waive any technicality in the form of the proposal.
