

PUBLIC NOTICE

Elko County, Nevada is soliciting comments on proposed Ordinance 2016-03, which will create a surcharge for enhancement or improvement of a telephone system used for reporting emergency (enhanced 911 surcharge).

The services to be provided will enable the 911 emergency dispatch operations to migrate to an enhanced 911 emergency dispatch with automatic telephone number and location connectivity with local PSAPS.

Upon receipt of the comments a business impact statement will be completed. This will be reviewed by the Board of County Commissioners at a public hearing prior to discussion of the proposed Ordinance 2016-03.

For comments to be included in the business impact statement they need to be received no later than 5:00 p.m., Pacific Time, on Wednesday, July 20, 2016. A copy of the impact statement can be found on the Elko County website at www.elkocountynv.net.
